schedule is as follows:

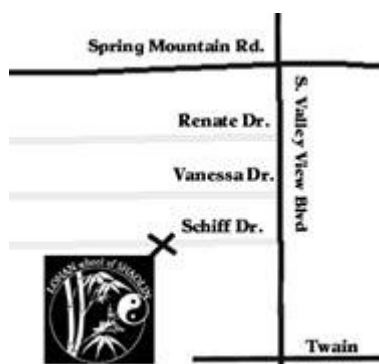
