**Priest Hours:**

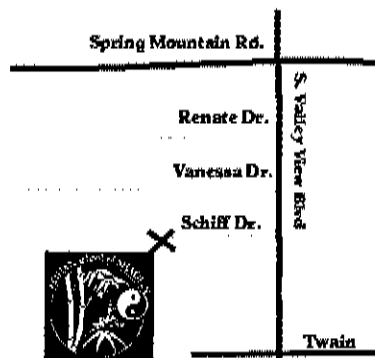
The Lohan priests have begun keeping hours in the Temple and are available for spiritual counseling, dharma questions or just to have a cup of tea. The current schedule is as follows:
